

Finger Knitting


You can knit with your fingers! You don't need needles....




Finger knitting in a pattern is a single stitch The result is very similar to single chain crochet.

You will need: Yarn leftovers

Technique: Tie a slip knot near the end of the yarn and slip it onto your index finger.




Hold the loose end of the yarn with your other three fingers.



Wrap the yarn over your finger to form a second loop in front of the first.

Pull the first loop over the second and off your finger. Tug the ends of the yarn to tighten the stitch.



Repeat these steps to form the cord. You can make a necklace or belt or a bracelet or cuff! Or even an animal.
