

Colourful Silhouettes

The Victorians liked using silhouettes in their artwork. Let's make some!

1. Look around your house for lots of colourful paper. It can be anything – magazines, newspaper, wrapping paper, scrap paper.
2. Cut these pieces into strips, and stick onto another piece of paper.
3. On a new piece of white or black paper, draw your design. Make sure it is big!
4. Carefully cut out your design from the centre, so you leave a hole in the paper in the outline of your design.
5. Place your hole-y paper over your coloured strips – your design is now coloured in!
6. Alternatively, you can cut out shapes in one colour to stick onto coloured strips, it's up to you!
