

T Shirt Refashion

Rosie decided to refashion one of her outgrown T Shirts. The T Shirt was one of her favourites so she wanted to make something to use the sequin design.

This is how Rosie did it in her own words!

- I first started to make it into a cushion cover but wasn't happy with it so I converted it into a bag!
- I had cut off the long sleeves so I stitched up the arm holes and sewed one of the sleeves to the top to make the strap.
- I cut the hem off the bottom and cut it into a fringe.
- I tied the strips of the fringe into knots to secure the bottom of the bag.
- I'm not very confident it is secure so I would stitch the bottom as well if I did it again!

- An old T Shirt, scissors, thread and a needle.
- The diagram below shows one way of transforming a T Shirt. It shows a sewing method and a no-sew method using the fringe and knots like Rosie!
